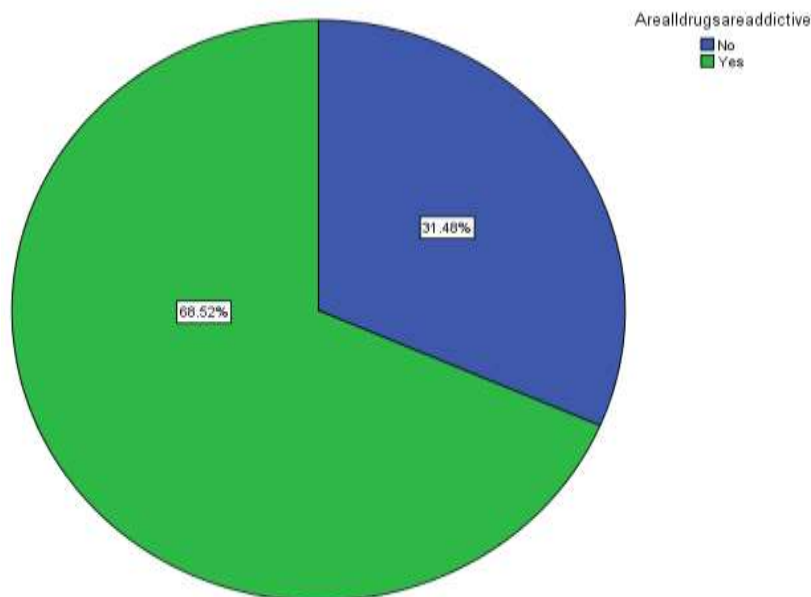

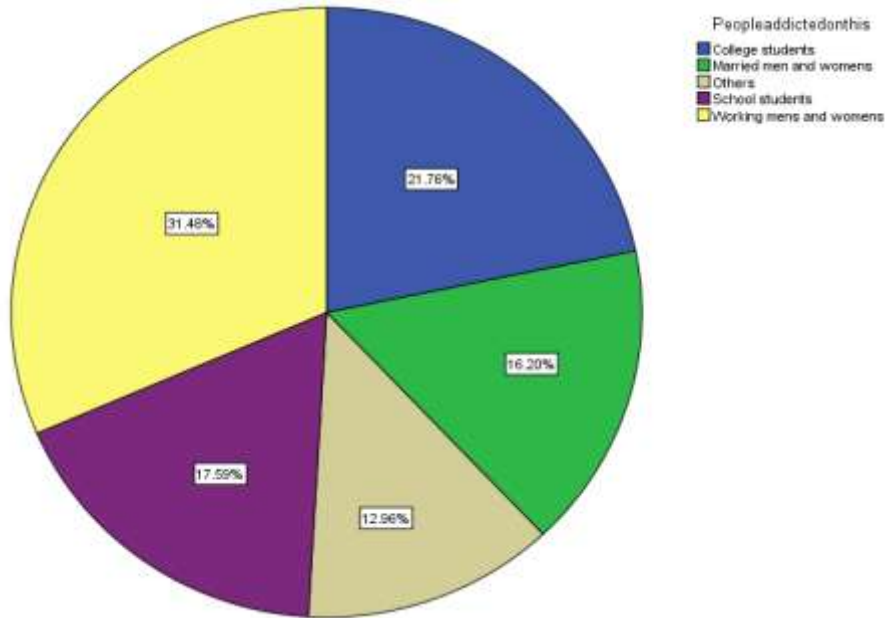

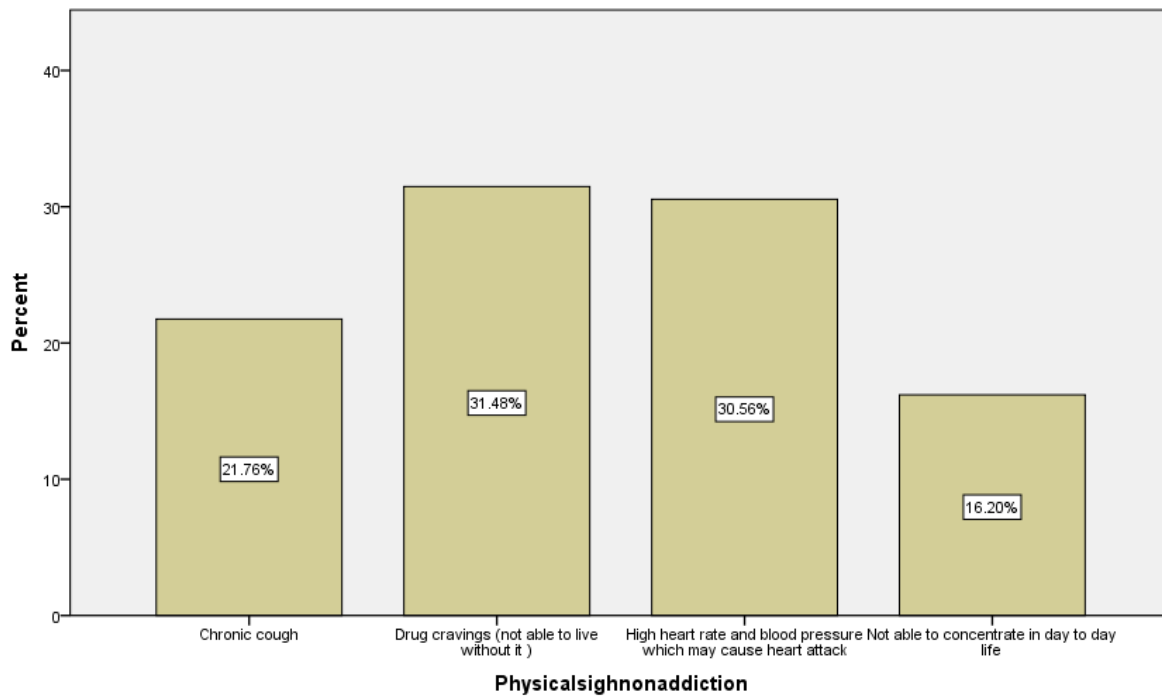
Legend: this figure no 1 shows the whether all the drug addictive or not

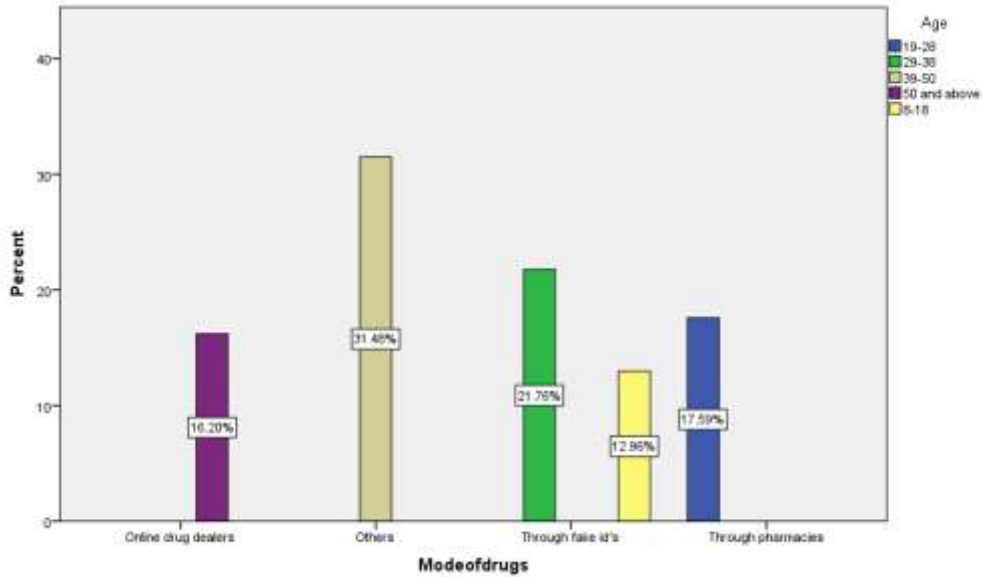
Legend: This figure shows the type of people addiction on this

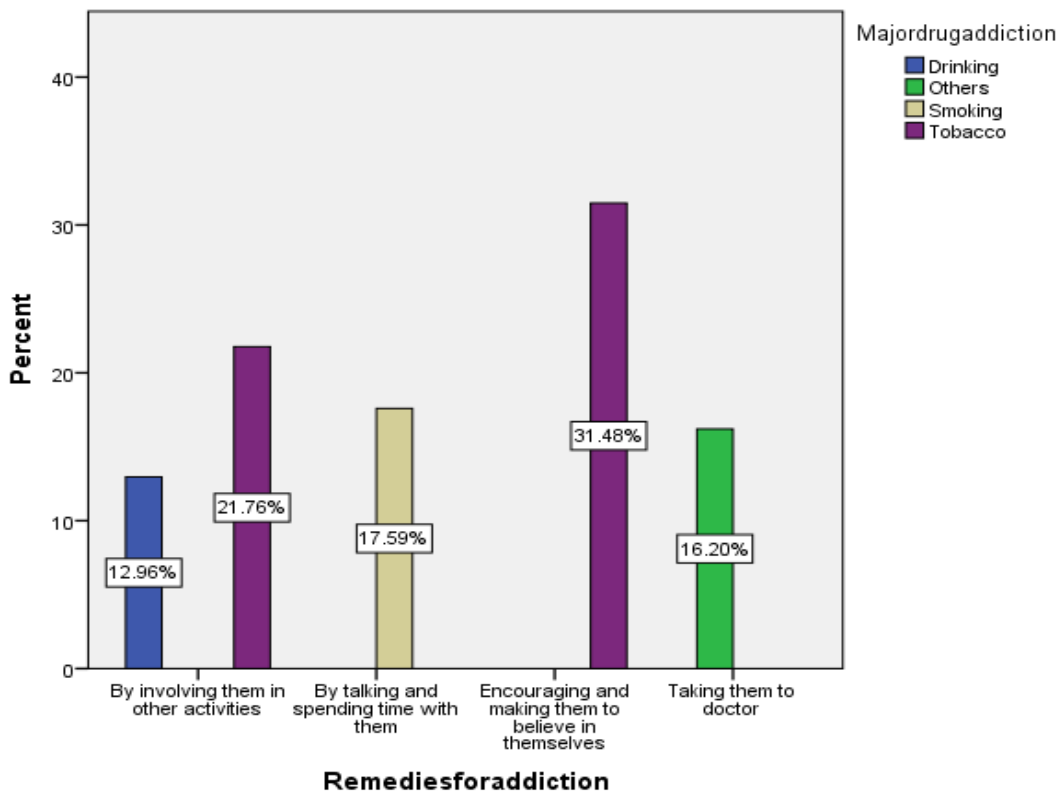
Legend: this figure no 3 the physical sign on addiction
